Financial (Elder Jerry DeYoung)

- Legacy Fund is to be moved to New Covenant Trust. \$ 35,000 removed from Legacy Fund to cover Furnace brain and to cover other bills as transfer is taking place.
- Other expenses remain on track with budget with electricity running high.

- Safe Church policy was written in 2005 and has not been updated since.

- Changes to page 12 of policy for Mandatory requirement for Volunteers to be active members of FPCD for a minimum of 6 months; or there can be exception with approval of session even when volunteers come from another church with similar programs.
